## Re-Entry Plan for 2021-2022 School Year (Updated 9/14/2021)

- Cleaning and Sanitizing provisions from last year will stay in place.
- Masks will be required for all students and staff (regardless of vaccination status) if the number of COVID positive and quarantined students for the county reaches five percent (5%) of the student population or greater.
- WCS will continue to work with the Health Department to conduct contact tracing when necessary. (Note: Vaccinated students/staff do not have to quarantine.)
- WCS will continue to monitor COVID data weekly, in conjunction with the Health Department, and adjust and/or revise our protocols if necessary.

- The Wirt County Board of Education grants the superintendent authority to revise the provisions in this plan, as needed, to then be ratified by the BOE at the next regularly scheduled meeting.
- At this time, Wirt County Schools will not be hosting any vaccination clinics on school grounds. Wirt County Schools is not a health care provider and believes that health care decisions must be left solely in the hands of parents and health care professionals. Parents interested in vaccinations (for themselves or their students) should contact Coplin Clinic to schedule an appointment.
