

MINUTES OF THE WIRT COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION

March 9, 2010

The Wirt County Board of Education met in their regular session on Tuesday, March 9, 2010, in the Wirt County High School cafeteria. Present were James Rader, President, Sheila Dye, Vice President, Jerry Ash, Mark Lowe, and Chuck Mills, members, Daniel Metz, Superintendent, and Karen Cummings, Treasurer.

Mr. Rader called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. On a motion by Mr. Ash, seconded by Mrs. Dye, the minutes of the previous meeting held on February 23, 2010, were approved.

Two members of the Wirt County Middle School football team were recognized for their successful season.

On a motion by Mr. Ash, seconded by Mrs. Dye, the Board approved payment of invoices totaling \$126,820.24, budget supplements totaling \$44,050.70, and approved revisions to the 2009-10 school calendar.

On a motion by Mr. Lowe, seconded by Mr. Mills, Christy Archer, Jesse Young, and Barb Siers were employed as substitute teachers.

On a motion by Mrs. Dye, seconded by Mr. Ash, the Board approved Jason Fox to complete field experience placement in Wirt County, and Meredith Crislip and Holly Moss Boone, to complete their internship in Wirt County Schools.

On a motion by Mrs. Dye, seconded by Mr. Lowe, a request was approved for Stella Allison Dunn to attend school in Wirt County from Ritchie for the 2010-2011 school year.

On a motion by Mr. Lowe, seconded by Mr. Mills, volunteers and chaperones were approved as recommended by the Superintendent.
