

MINUTES OF THE WIRT COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION

March 23, 2010

The Wirt County Board of Education met in their regular session on Tuesday, March 23, 2010, in the Wirt County High School cafeteria. Present were James Rader, President, Sheila Dye, Vice President, Jerry Ash, Mark Lowe, and Chuck Mills, members, Daniel Metz, Superintendent, and Karen Cummings, Treasurer.

Mr. Rader called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. On a motion by Mr. Ash, seconded by Mr. Lowe, the minutes of the previous meeting held on March 9, 2010, were approved.

The Board recognized the members of the Wirt County High School Wrestling Team and congratulated them on their successful season.

On a motion by Mr. Mills, seconded by Mr. Lowe, the Board entered into an executive session at 6:15 to conduct a student discipline hearing. The meeting returned to regular session at 7:15 p.m. on a motion by Mr. Ash, seconded by Mr. Mills. On a motion by Mr. Mills, seconded by Mr. Lowe, the Board voted to expel a Wirt County High School student for 365 days for possession of a controlled substance on school property and violations of the Student Code of Conduct.

On a motion by Mr. Ash, seconded by Mr. Lowe, the Board approved payment of invoices totaling \$78,245.52, budget supplements totaling \$334,631.33, and budget transfers totaling \$35,957.

On a motion by Mr. Lowe, seconded by Mr. Mills, the Board approved the Schedule of Proposed Levy Rates.

On a motion by Mr. Ash, seconded by Mrs. Dye, the Board approved a \$3000 allocation for the Senior Tribute Dinner and Ceremony.

On a motion by Mrs. Dye, seconded by Mr. Ash, the Board employed Susan Roberts as Tutor for the Eighth Grade, funded through the GEAR UP Grant, and Robert Beatty as Assistant Varsity Baseball Coach, Wirt County High School.

On a motion by Mr. Lowe, seconded by Mr. Mills, the Board approved Austin Wilson, Elizabeth Perdue, Brett A. Dennis, and Chloe Murray to attend Wirt County Schools.

On a motion by Mrs. Dye, seconded by Mr. Ash, the Board approved John Sams and Alicia Jenkins as Volunteers/Chaperones.

On a motion by Mr. Lowe, seconded by Mr. Ash, the Board approved Wirt County Schools Policies JB: Regulations for the Education of Students With Exceptionalities, IA: Universal Access to a Quality Education System, and CG-A: Return to Work Policy.

The next meeting of the Wirt County Board of Education will be held on Tuesday, April 13, 2010.

The meeting recessed until April 23, 2010.
