

MINUTES OF THE WIRT COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION

July 27, 2010

The Wirt County Board of Education met in their regular session on Tuesday, July 27, 2010, in the Wirt County High School cafeteria. Present were James Rader, President, Carl Brainard, Mark Lowe, and Chuck Mills, members, Daniel Metz, Superintendent, and Karen Cummings, Treasurer. Board Vice President Jerry Ash was present via teleconference.

Mr. Rader called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. On a motion by Mr. Lowe, seconded by Mr. Mills, the minutes of the previous meeting held on July 13, 2010 were approved.

On a motion by Mr. Mills, seconded by Mr. Lowe, the Board approved payment of invoices totaling \$52,464.85, budget supplements totaling \$35,374.00, and budget transfers totaling \$4,825.00. By the same motion, the Board approved Public Official Bonds for Karen Cummings, Daniel Metz, and James Rader.

On a motion by Mr. Mills, seconded by Mr. Ash, the Board approved a leave of absence for Stephanie Martin, employed Kristen Reeder as Special Education Teacher at Wirt Primary, and approved Shanel Watson as a volunteer volleyball coach at Wirt High, pending certification, and John Nemeth as a volunteer football coach at Wirt Middle School, pending certification.
