

MINUTES OF THE WIRT COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION

September 28, 2010

The Wirt County Board of Education met in their regular session on Tuesday, September 28, 2010 in the Wirt County High School cafeteria. Present were James Rader, President, Jerry Ash, Vice President, Carl Brainard, Mark Lowe, and Chuck Mills, members; and Daniel Metz, Superintendent.

Mr. Rader called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. On a motion by Mr. Brainard, seconded by Mr. Ash, the minutes of the previous meeting held on September 14, 2010, were approved.

On a motion by Mr. Lowe, seconded by Mr. Ash, the Board approved payment of invoices totaling \$63,118.12, and budget transfers totaling \$5,634.76. By the same motion the Board approved the Annual Financial Report.

On a motion by Mr. Ash, seconded by Mr. Brainard, the Board accepted the resignation of Lacey Mills as assistant girls' basketball coach at Wirt County High School. By the same motion the following personnel were employed:

On a motion by Mr. Brainard, seconded by Mr. Ash, the Board approved volunteers/chaperones as recommended by the Superintendent.

On a motion by Mr. Ash, seconded by Mr. Brainard, the Board approved the placement of Douglas Newberry for field experience at Wirt Primary and Wirt Middle Schools.

On a motion by Mr. Mills, seconded by Mr. Lowe, the Board granted an exception to Wirt County File: JB-R, Attendance for a Wirt County High School student.
