

MINUTES OF THE WIRT COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION

November 9, 2010

The members of the Wirt County Board of Education met in their regular session on Tuesday, November 9, 2010, in the Wirt County High School cafeteria. Present were James Rader, President, Jerry Ash, Vice President, Carl Brainard, Mark Lowe, and Chuck Mills, members, Daniel Metz, Superintendent, and Karen Cummings, Treasurer.

Mr. Rader called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. On a motion by Mr. Lowe, seconded by Mr. Mills, the minutes of the previous meeting held on October 26, 2010, were approved.

Mr. Ken Heiney, Principal of Wirt County High School, representing the Wirt County High School LSIC, led the Board on a tour of selected classrooms of Wirt County High School, to meet with teachers and students, showing the use of technology and netbooks in the classrooms.

On a motion by Mr. Ash, seconded by Mr. Brainard, the Board approved payment of invoices totaling \$148,443.13

On a motion by Mr. Lowe, seconded by Mr. Mills, the Board accepted the resignations of Kimberly Cheeseman, aide, effective November 12, 2010, and Carol Frame, substitute secretary, effective January 1, 2011.

On a motion by Mr. Ash, seconded by Mr. Brainard, the Board voted to abolish the position of Cook/Custodian at Wirt Primary/Middle School and authorized the positions of Cook II (B), WCPC/WCMS, 200-day employment contract, and Custodian (C), WCPC/WCMS, 200-day employment contract.

On a motion by Mr. Lowe, seconded by Mr. Mills, the Board approved volunteers/chaperones as recommended by the Superintendent.

The next meeting of the Wirt County Board of Education will be held on November 23, 2010, at Wirt County Middle School.

On a motion by Mr. Ash, seconded by Mr. Mills, the meeting adjourned.
