

MINUTES OF THE WIRT COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION

November 23, 2010

The members of the Wirt County Board of Education met in their regular session on Tuesday, November 23, 2010, at the Wirt County Middle School. Present were James Rader, President, Jerry Ash, Vice President, Carl Brainard, Mark Lowe, and Chuck Mills, members, and Daniel Metz, Superintendent.

Mr. Rader called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. On a motion by Mr. Lowe, seconded by Mr. Mills, the minutes of the previous meeting held on November 9, 2010, were approved.

Representatives of the Wirt County Middle School Local School Improvement Council gave presentations regarding academics and goals for their school for the year. Representing Wirt County Middle School were John McKown, Principal, Eloise Jones, teacher, Kim Poling, teacher, and students Elizabeth Adams and Megan Burns.

On a motion by Mr. Ash, seconded by Mr. Lowe, the Board approved payment of invoices totaling \$74,633.15, and budget transfers totaling \$50,730.52.
