Does Wirt County have Title I schools? Yes, both Wirt Primary and Wirt Middle are Title I schools.

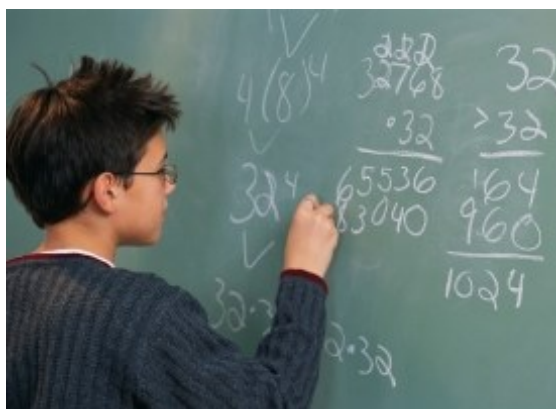
Title I @WCPC
