

MINUTES OF THE WIRT COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION

The Wirt County Board of Education met in Special Session on Monday, December 11, 2017 at 6:00 pm in the Wirt County High School Cafeteria for the purpose of a Student Discipline Hearing. Present were: Carl Brainard, president, Mark Lowe, Johnny Nemeth, Robert Deuley, Dan Metz, members and MaryJane Pope Albin, secretary.

Mr. Brainard called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm, the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Superintendent, MaryJane Pope Albin.

Student disciplinary hearing (s) in regard to the recommendation of expulsion for 365 days for violation of 18A-5-1a “possession of a firearm or deadly weapon, nor conceal a firearm, as defined in WVA Code §61-7-2, on the premises of an education facility, at a school sponsored function or on a school bus, WVDE/WCS Expected Behavior in Safe and Supportive Schools Policy was held.

Mr. Brainard explained to the student and parent that these proceedings would be recorded. He asked the parent of student if she wished an open or closed hearing. Mother requested a closed hearing for her minor child. Mr. Lowe made a motion at 6:01 pm to go into executive session for the purpose of conducting a student discipline hearing. At 6:31 Mr. Nemeth, made a motion to return to regular session. Mr. Nemeth made a motion to accept the superintendent's recommendation that student be expelled for 365 days

Superintendent Albin explained Alternative Education program.
